QUESTIONS

Where do we park? YMCA Craft Fair vendors may park in one of two locations: in the parking lot just located behind the Blacksburg Aquatic Center parking lot (near the skate park and tennis courts); or in the old high school parking lot located across the street and beyond the track (vehicles with trailers must park here).

When and where will we unload? On Friday morning, November 13, unloading will occur at one of three building entrance points, dependent on your booth location. Two points lead right into the event room, and one is just an indoor ramp away from the event room. Many carts and volunteers, mostly VT students, will be on hand to assist you with unloading!

*Do all booths have electricity available if we pay the extra fee? **NO.*** There are only 3 circuits at 20 amps (2,400 watts) each available in the space allowing a limited amount of vendor spaces with power available. Priority will be given to returning vendors requesting and paying for power.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All craft vendor booth spaces will be 10ft x 10ft
- All booths with electricity available will be located around the edges of the gymnasium.
- LED bulbs only. Electric usage will be checked if a circuit becomes overloaded, and the offending items will need to be disconnected.
- Do not use duct tape or other types of tape on the gymnasium floor. This can damage the floor and could incur a repair charge for offenders. If you need items taped to the floor, please find a volunteer and ask for Jim to assist. Jim will provide gaffer tape which can be used on this surface.
